## DATA USE AND CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

## for access to data from the 2015 Computational Linguistics and Clinical Psychology Shared Task

Johns Hopkins University on behalf of itself, its affiliates, and the organizers of the Computational Linguistics and Clinical Psychology Workshops (collectively, "JHU") controls certain data, in the form of social media data, which have been de-identified within the meaning of the Johns Hopkins University Institutional Review Board Privacy Rule (the "Data"). JHU wishes to make the Data, in the form of one or more "Datasets," available to eligible participants as a byproduct of the Computational Linguistics and Clinical Psychology Workshops and Shared Task Competition (the "Competition"). JHU is making the Data available solely for the purpose of enabling registrants to conduct research (the "Purpose").

This Data Use and Confidentiality Agreement explains the terms and conditions of access to the Data by registrants in the Competition. ANY REGISTRANT WHO WISHES TO ACCESS THE DATA MUST READ AND AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS BY ENTERING THE INFORMATION REQUESTED BELOW, SIGNING AND RETURNING THE AGREEMENT TO IHU AS DIRECTED BELOW.

- 1. Registrant understands and agrees that any Data / Datasets that JHU provides to Registrant are proprietary and confidential to JHU.
- 2. Registrant agrees that Registrant will use the Data / Datasets solely for research purposes and for no other purpose.
- 3. Registrant agrees that Registrant will not attempt to identify, re-identify, contact, or influence any individual or group from the Data / Datasets. Furthermore, Registrant agrees that Registrant will not reproduce any portion, excerpt, or example of the Data / Datasets in any published works or public venues, to prevent re-identification from others.
- 4. Registrant agrees that, unless requires by law or court order, Registrant will not disclose, disseminate, or otherwise share the Data / Datasets to or with any other person or entity except with persons or entities on Registrant's Research team, as expressly listed below, each of which persons/entities Registrant will inform of the obligations with respect to use and confidentiality of the Data under this Agreement:

To the extent permitted by law, registrant shall be responsible for compliance by these persons/entities with the terms of this Agreement and any breach thereof. Registrant shall also be responsible to protect the Data / Datasets from unauthorized access and under security protocols that registrant applies to its own data of similar nature.

- 5. Registrant agrees not to use the name or logo of Johns Hopkins University or any of its affiliates or any of their respective trustees, directors, officers, staff members, employees, students or agents for any purpose without JHUs' prior written approval excepting in the course of presentation and or publication deriving from the Competition wherein the data source is acknowledged. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing herein shall restrict Registrant's right to disclose the existence of this Agreement, the identity of its parties, or the nature and scope of the Purpose.
- 6. All Data / Datasets disclosed pursuant to this Agreement, including without limitation all written and tangible forms thereof, shall be and remain the property of JHU. Upon termination of this Agreement as provided in Section 7 below, Registrant shall cease using the Data / Datasets.
- 7. JHU may terminate Registrant's access to Data / Datasets under this Agreement for any reason upon thirty (30) days' prior written notice to Registrant.

Registrants are expressly prohibited from using Data / Datasets for commercial purposes of any kind, including but not limited to algorithm development or evaluation, model development or evaluation, evaluation of features, feature engineering, reports, or visualizations used for any for-profit purpose, where for-profit purposes include but are not limited to prototyping, product development, marketing, public relations, or pursuit of funding.

- 8. Registrant represents that they have obtained permission from their organization's Institutional Review Board (IRB) or equivalent ethics committee. Registrant agrees to follow any guidelines set forth by the committee, including for the storage and protection of the data. Registrant agrees to follow the research protocols as approved by the committee.
- 9. Registrant acknowledges that the appropriate paper for citation for publications

that make use of Data / Datasets is as follows:
