- You may apply up to 2 appropriate non-JHU graduate courses toward the PhD course requirements solely with your advisor's approval. These must be in Computer Science, or a closely related field such as Electrical and Computer Engineering, Cognitive Science, Mathematics, or Mathematical Sciences, and would serve as electives. The Computer Science Director of Graduate Studies, Dr. Scott Smith, does not need to approve these 2 courses if those are the only courses you intend to transfer in. In that case scenario, your advisor's signature on your [PhD Coursework Completion Worksheet](#) is sufficient.
- If you are willing to forego JHU's CS MSE degree then you may apply more than 2 appropriate non-JHU graduate courses toward the PhD course requirements with the approval of Dr. Smith. To request his approval, please email this completed sheet along with a PDF of your transcript to scott@cs.jhu.edu.
- Note the courses requested for transfer cannot have counted toward an undergraduate degree or have been taken as an undergraduate at another institution.
